## Section 2.7

## **REMOVAL OF BOARD MEMBERS**

- A. A Board member shall be removed from the Board by his/her Appointing Authority for neglect of duty, misconduct, malfeasance, failure to attend at least one in-service training session each year; a violation of division (A), (B), (C), or (D) of Section 5126.03 of the Revised Code, or the absence of a member within one year from either four Board meetings with prior notice or from two Board meetings without prior notice. This removal provision does not apply to absences from special meetings or work sessions.
- B. The Board shall supply the Board member and his/her Appointing Authority with written notice of the charges against the member.
- C. The member's Appointing Authority shall afford the member an opportunity for a hearing, in accordance with the procedures it adopts and shall upon determination that the charges are accurate, remove the member and appoint another person to complete the member's term.
- D. A member removed from the Board is ineligible for reappointment for not less than one year.

As used in this policy, "Appointing Authority" means the Board of County Commissioners or the Probate Judge.
