DO NOT RESUSCITATE ORDERS AND ADVANCED DIRECTIVES

Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to ensure all employees are knowledgeable of and comply with the laws of the State of Ohio when an individual enrolled in a Board program or a County Board Employee has a legally executed Advanced Directive or Do Not Resuscitate Order.

Application:

All Board employees will follow the Ohio DNR protocol by taking the following steps:

- 1. 911 will be called immediately when there is a life-threatening situation. Once the EMS arrives they will be given the information concerning the Do Not Resuscitate Order or Advanced Directive.
 - a. Until the EMS arrives the staff will provide first aid to the individual including:
 - Splinting or immobilizing any break
 - Controlling any bleeding
 - Positioning the person for comfort
 - Providing emotional support
 - b. Nursing will administer medication, oxygen, and suction the individual's airway if there is a physician's order and the supplies to do so. Supplies much be provided by the individual.
 - c. Staff <u>will not</u> administer Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) including chest compression or respiratory assistance nor will staff use the Automated External Defibrillator (AED)
- 2. Staff will call the nurse and facility manager to monitor the situation.
- 3. The individual's parent, legal guardian or closest relative will be notified of the situation by the nurse or facility manager.
- 4. All Advanced Directives and Do Not Resuscitate Orders shall be kept in the individual's nursing file and updated as necessary. Each file will be marked with a yellow dot indicating that one of the contents of the file is a Do Not Resuscitate Order/Advanced Directive.

- 5. Employees who need to know information about individual Do Not Resuscitate Orders/Advanced Directives will receive this training as needed from the nursing staff. Training and information may include, but not limited to:
 - What the Do Not Resuscitate Order or Advanced Directive says;
 - What to do if a Do Not Resuscitate Order or Advanced Directive is verbally revoked at the time of crisis; and
 - Other pertinent information nurses feel they need to share in order for staff to legally honor Do Not Resuscitate Orders and/or Advanced Directives.
