Interviewer: Getting your drivers license is something you've wanted for a long time and at times it seemed impossible, but here you are. What advice do you have for someone going through something similar?



Interviewer: Now that you have your license, what's next? **Justin:** I want a full-time job at Accessible's main office because I like working for them.








