PRESCHOOL TRANSITION

Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to outline the roles and responsibilities of the Trumbull County Board of Developmental Disabilities in the provision of preschool transition services.

Policy:

Preschool transition services are designed to assist preschool students in a smooth transition from early intervention services to the Board's preschool program or from the preschool program to the Board's school-age program or any school-age program chosen by parents. The Trumbull County Board of Developmental Disabilities will provide information and support to families in order to facilitate transition during these important milestones for the student and family. The Trumbull County Board of Developmental Disabilities' Fairhaven School will adhere to the timelines and mandated steps for transition through the Individualized Family Services Plan (IFSP) or Individualized Education Program (IEP) process or through the general education program process.

Transition services provided by the Trumbull County Board of Developmental Disabilities are developed in accordance with existing Board policy as well as all pertinent state and federal rules, regulations and laws.

Preschool transition services shall focus on the preferences of the family as well as the needs and strengths of the student. The Trumbull County Board of Developmental Disabilities will work in collaboration with the public-school systems and early intervention program to ensure a seamless transition.
