SCHOOL AGE TRANSITION

Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to outline the roles and responsibilities of the Trumbull County Board of Developmental Disabilities in the provision of school age transition services.

Policy:

School age transition services are designed to meet the needs of students, 14 years of age and older, in preparing them for transition from school to post-school activities. Post-school activities may include college, vocational training, continuing and adult education, employment, independent living and community participation.

School-age transition services shall focus on the preferences, interests, needs and strengths of the student based on the data gathered annually through the Age Appropriate Transition Assessment and included in the student's individualized education program. Transition services provided by the Trumbull County Board of Developmental Disabilities are developed in accordance with existing Board policy as well as all pertinent state and federal rules, regulations and laws. Transition services provided by the Board are also designed to meet the standards as set forth by the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF).

The Trumbull County Board of Developmental Disabilities will work in collaboration with Opportunities for Ohioans with Disabilities (OOD), Trumbull County Educational Services Center (ESC), Trumbull Career and Technical Center (TCTC) and all Trumbull County school districts to provide transitional services as determined by the individualized education plan for eligible students.

It is at the discretion of the superintendent to serve individuals who have not been deemed eligible for county board services as determined by the Ohio Eligibility Determination Instrument (OEDI).
