## **HOLIDAYS**

## Purpose:

This policy outlines the holidays observed by the Trumbull County Board of Developmental Disabilities and allows time off with pay for eligible employees on each of the holidays listed.

## Policy:

A. All eligible employees are entitled to the following twelve (12) holidays:

New Years Day	First Day of January
Martin Luther King Day	Third Monday in January
President's Day	Third Monday in February
Friday Before Easter	
Memorial Day	Fourth Monday of May
Juneteenth	Nineteenth day of June
Independence Day	Fourth Day of July
Labor Day	First Monday in September
Thanksgiving Day	Fourth Thursday in November
Day after Thanksgiving	Fourth Friday in November
	(in-lieu of Columbus Day)
Day before Christmas	Twenty-Fourth Day of December
	(in-lieu of Veterans Day)
Christmas Day	Twenty-Fifth Day of December

- B. If a holiday falls on Saturday, it will be observed on the preceding Friday; if it falls on Sunday, it will be observed on the following Monday.
- C. If a holiday occurs while an employee is on vacation or sick leave, vacation or sick leave will not be deducted from the employee's accrued balance. Employees in inactive pay status are not entitled to holiday pay.
